Robert E. Howe, age 72, Lake Twp. Trustee died of an apparent heart attack Wednesday evening, March 10, after doing volunteer work at the Eagles Club in Caseville.

He was born March 15, 1926 in Detroit to the late Theodore and Margaret (Keller) Howe.
