Ralph (Bud) was born on September 9,, 1930, in Loud Township, Atlanta MI, to Howard and Neva (Graves) Klein. On June 19, 1954, he married his high school sweetheart Geraldine (Gerry) Briley. Bud graduated from Atlanta High School 1949, he then spent 2 years working on a Great Lakes freighter until he was drafted into the Army. He served as a Sargent in the Korean War, he was an artillery mechanic stationed in Korea.
