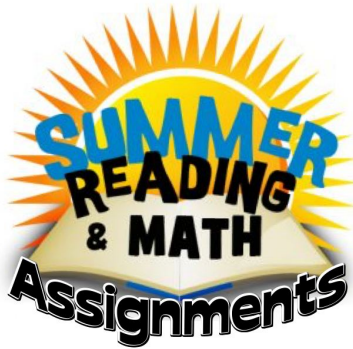

Please select, purchase, and read **ONE** of the following books. Themes include friendship, self-reliance, empathy, and compassion to name a few and are aligned with our reading curriculum. Bring the book to school on the first day and as directed thereafter. Be prepared to discuss and respond in writing about characters, setting, plot, and theme.

Island of the Blue Dolphins – Scott O’Dell - tells the story of a 12-year-old girl named Karana stranded alone for years on an island off the California coast.

Hatchet – Gary Paulson - tells the story of 13-year-old Brian Robeson and his successful attempt to survive alone in the wilderness.

My Side of the Mountain – Jean Craighead George - tells the fictional account of how Sam Gibley survives in the wilderness of upstate New York.

The Bridge to Terabithia – Katherine Paterson – tells the story of two lonely children who create a magical forest kingdom in their imaginations.
