State Officer Candidates:

State Officer Candidate, "Officer Intent to Run Applications" are located on the SkillsUSA Kansas Website <https://www.skillsusakansas.org/resources-1.html>. Applications are to be submitted by September 20th. All candidates will participate in a Zoom meeting on September 21st, then participate in the State Officer Candidate "Boot Camp" Workshop on September 28th.

State Officer Candidates will begin the election process on Sunday evening, October 6th, with interviews from business and industry, the Kansas Board of Directors, and the State Officer Team, then join the Kansas Delegation on October 7th where they will give two speeches and answer impromptu question before the Kansas delegation.

More detailed information will be sent out to applicants once their application is received by the State Director and State Officer Trainer.

If elected State Officer, orientation will follow the next morning on October 8th. Schools, please be prepared to make arrangement for your State Officer Candidates if they are elected to serve. Tuesday evening hotel expenses will be covered by the State Office for one advisor per school and newly elected officers. All newly elected State Officers are required to attend all scheduled meetings starting October 8th. State Officer Schedule is on the application form.

Statesmen Award (Individual)

This is an award given to all members if they complete the Statesman requirements during the Fall Leadership Conference. Members will be given the Statesman worksheet during the first District meeting. Once members recite and complete the worksheet they will submit the document to the lead advisor in their district to be submitted to the SkillsUSA Headquarters office for review no later than 3pm as scheduled in the Fall Leadership Conference agenda.

Kansas Delegation

The Kansas Delegation is made up of members from across the state. Each district, according to their district constitution will appoint 7 High School members and 7 Postsecondary members to serve as voting delegates. Voting delegates are usually those who are elected as District Officers serving in their district. High School and College/Postsecondary Divisions will have separate voting ballots during the election process. High School delegates will only elect high school State officers, and Postsecondary delegates will only elect Postsecondary State officers.
