

HOLE IN ONE PROCEDURE:

A holding account (\$25 or less) contributed by each active Titan is maintained in our treasury to cover future hole in ones. This eliminates collection of individual payments from everyone each time someone gets a hole in one. As the fund is consumed it will be replenished by active members at year end or as needed. The payout for a Hole in One award is \$500 which includes payment of the bar bill by the Titans with the remaining cash awarded to the Hole in One golfer. The Titans will also award a trophy to the lucky member.
