### **Biography**

Ann Ross-Hudson was an active member of Presbyterian churches in Bad Axe, Michigan and Sarasota, Florida, serving at one time as state president of Presbyterian Women in Michigan and as a Stephen minister in Florida. Her college

plans were interrupted by marriage and WW II. It was 23 years later that she graduated from Michigan State University. Faculty there immediately recruited her to become an MSU Extension agent and she served in Huron, Sanilac, Tuscola, and later Eaton counties from 1965 to 1982. In many trips to East Lansing she helped develop and then pilot numerous programs that were later rolled out statewide. She earned national recognition for Cooperative Extension and made two trips to Belize organizing an exchange of women. She was on the Bad Axe Library Board and a member of the American Association of University Women (AAUW). She loved fellow couples in Supper Club, hosting members of her family, and travel.
