It is a great feeling and fantastic looking short hunting bow – perhaps the best shooting short hunting bow ever produced. This particular Cascade in very good condition. No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. NO drilled holes. No crazing. A few light superficial stress lines on the back near the riser. A few very minor scratches and scuffs here and there. This is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. In 2020 inflation-adjusted dollars, this bow would cost \$710 today. Comes with a serviceable string.
