

ORDINANCE NO 106 G

An ordinance calling for an election on May 8, 2010 for the purpose of electing City Officials for the City of Log Cabin, Texas.

Be it ordained by the City of Log Cabin City Council:

Section I

An election is hereby ordered to be held in the City of Log Cabin, Texas on May 8, 2010, same being the second Saturday in May, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Election to be held at City Hall in the City Council meeting room for the purpose of electing the following officials: Three (3) Councilpersons for the term of two (2) years.

Section II

That Terry Rukes is hereby appointed Presiding Judge of the election and Gloria McDaniel is appointed Alternate Judge. The Presiding Election Judge is granted authority to appoint as many election clerks as deemed necessary to properly conduct said election without prior or subsequent approval or ratification by the City Council of the City of Log Cabin, Texas.

Section III

That the official ballot of said election on May 8, 2010, shall substantially comply with the laws of the State of Texas Governing Municipal Elections.

Section IV

That only qualified voters shall be eligible to vote at said election in the City of Log Cabin, Texas.

Section V


That Pat Hayes, City Secretary, is hereby appointed clerk for early voting. The early voting shall be held at 14387 Alamo Road, Log Cabin, Texas in the City Council meeting room. **Early voting shall begin on April 26, 2010 and end on May 4, 2010. The hours of early voting will be from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.**

each day with the exception of April 26, 2010 and May 1, 2010 when the poll will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section VI

That notice of said election shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Henderson County. Said publication shall not be less than ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days before the election. The Mayor is hereby instructed to cause such notice to be given.
