I declare that sin shall no longer be master over me because I am not under the law, but under grace, and there is no more guilt or condemnation because I am spiritually alive in Christ Jesus.

I renounce every unrighteous use of my body and I commit myself to no longer be conformed to this world, but rather to be transformed by the renewing of my mind, and I chooses to believe the truth and walk in it regardless of my feelings or circumstances.

I commit myself to take every thought captive to the obedience of Christ; I choose to think upon that which is true, honorable, right, pure and lovely.

I commit myself to God's great goal for my life which is to conform to His image.

I choose to adopt that attitude of Christ, to do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit; with humility of mind I will regard others as more important than myself, not merely looking out for my own personal interest, but also for the interests of others.
