



Meeting Minutes March 3rd 2020

Motion made to accept the minutes from February 4th 2020. Motion passed.

Bank balance is \$40,509.51 in the MMA . \$6042.67 in the operating account.

We are still waiting on a billing for the B service on snow cat repairs. Estimated at \$22,000.00.

Mark submitted a billing for \$7,340.15 for grooming costs thru February 28th. That is paid out of the portion of funds that the State Parks received \$14,000.00 in total. The fuel cost was \$2,862.88, wages were \$4,477.27. Mark's wages are not included as he is a state employee; he has put in 104.6 hours as a volunteer.

We are posting grooming reports as received from the operators of the groomer on the CSA trail grooming site. Grooming is expected to continue thru the end of March, if weather conditions prevail on as they are, the Qualey Trail and low country creek crossings are the determining conditions.

The Wounded Warriors are here this weekend. Expected to ride out on 42 Saturday at 10 AM from the marina. Potluck dinner is Saturday night at the Charter School. Dinner starts at 5:30 PM. A total of 17 warriors are here. They are staying at Historic Columbine. This year no one has signed up for the ice fishing on Steamboat Lake.

We will hold the last meeting of the season on March 31st at the Roadhouse. Beer and burgers beginning at 6:00 to celebrate another season.

Capital needs for snow cat maintenance service, trail improvements, and signage can be included in this year's grant requests. Meeting is in May, so please let Todd know if you have something in mind.
