1. We return from Spring Break refreshed for the final push to the end of the school year. This week parents and students participated in SEP Conferences with their teachers both to celebrate the growth shown as well as to review areas for continued improvement. We are proud of the hard work students, teachers, and families have put into this especially difficult school year!
2. Enrollment Season is ongoing and our numbers keep climbing! Last year we finished the year with 126 students, this year we increased enrollment to our current number of 143 students - a 13% increase highlighted in a recent NCEA article and podcast with Mr. McFall. Numbers for next year are already at 162 with inquiries continuing strong - another 13% increase. If we reach our goal of 170 students (only 8 more), we will have increased enrollment by 33% in under 2 years. God is at work at Saint Olaf, both in our parish and school! We are so grateful to serve our families alongside our parish. Catholic Education makes a difference.
