ORDINANCE NO. 1160

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XII, ARTICLE 2 OF THE HORTON MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING A RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD IN THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Chapter XII, Article 2 of the Horton Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"CHAPTER XII, ARTICLE 2. PARKS AND RECREATION SYSTEM

12-201. RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD ESTABLISHED. (a) There is hereby established a recreation advisory board that shall consist of four members to be appointed by the governing body of the City of Horton, Kansas to serve as follows: the first appointee to serve for four years, the second for three years, the third for two years, and the fourth for one year. Following the initial appointment, members' terms shall be for four years.

(b) Whenever a vacancy shall occur in the membership of the advisory board, a replacement shall be selected by the governing body of the City of Horton, Kansas to fill such vacancy for the unexpired term of the member he or she is succeeding.

12-202. RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD DUTIES. The recreation advisory board shall meet regularly and serve as an advisory board to the governing body of the City of Horton, Kansas on all matters concerning the parks and recreation system of the City of Horton, Kansas.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 1161

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2016.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Horton, Kansas;

Section 1. **INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE.** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Horton, Kansas, that certain standard code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2016, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1161," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. **REPEAL.** Ordinance number 1147 is repealed.

Section 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 1162

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2016 PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1148.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Horton, Kansas;

Section 1. **INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Horton, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2016, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1162," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

Section 2. **TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES.**

(a) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A. Supp. 8-2118.

(b) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions as defined in subsection (a) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses.

Section 3. **PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES.** The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the municipal judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall not be less than \$10 nor more than \$500, except for speeding which shall not be less than \$10 or more than \$100. A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$500.

Section 4. **REPEAL.** Ordinance number 1148 is repealed.

Section 5. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 2017- 1163

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 182.1 OF THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2016, TO COMPLY WITH KANSAS STATUTE.

WHEREAS, current Standard Traffic Ordinance Section 182.1 requires Municipal Courts to impose a \$10 fine for seat belt violations; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2017, Kansas Senate Bill 89 requires Municipal Courts to impose a \$30 fine for seat belt violations, and send \$20 of that fine to the State of Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Horton, Kansas desires to amend the fine portion of Section 182.1 of the Standard Traffic Ordinance to comply with the requirement set forth in Senate Bill 89;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE AFORESTATED PREMISES, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Kansas Senate Bill 89, Section 182.1(d) of the 2016 Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, previously adopted by reference by the City of Horton, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(d)(1) Persons violating subsection (a)(1) shall be fined \$30 and no court costs; and

(2) Persons violating subsection (a)(2) shall be fined \$60 and no court costs.

Section 2. As required by Kan. Stat. Ann. 12-4120(c), on and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the amount of \$20 from each fine imposed for a violation of Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, Section 182.1(a)(1) shall be remitted by the Municipal Court Clerk to the Kansas State Treasurer.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the official city newspaper.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED IN THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE ZONING REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That having received a recommendation from the Planning Commission, and proper notice having been given and hearing held as provided by law and under the authority of and subject to the provisions of the Zoning Regulations of the City of Horton, Kansas, the zoning classification or districts of the lands legally described hereby are changed as follows:

Zone change from R1 to AG-1 for property located at 1205 9th Ave West, Horton, Kansas, legally described as follows:

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, in Block H, in West Horton Addition to the City of Horton, Brown County, Kansas;

and

Lots 6,7,8,9 and 10, in Block H, and Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, in Block I, all in West Horton Addition to the City of Horton, Brown County, Kansas

SECTION 2. That upon the taking effect of this Ordinance, the above zoning changes shall be entered and shown on the "Official Zoning Map" previously adopted by reference, and said official zoning map is hereby reincorporated as a part of the Zoning Regulation as amended.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption by the City Commission and publication in the official City newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 1165

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE VACATING OF THAT PORTION OF WEST 9TH STREET LOCATED BETWEEN 5TH AVENUE WEST AND 6TH AVENUE WEST IN THE CITY OF HORTON, BROWN COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS the City Commission of Horton, Kansas, has been requested to vacate a street located as follows, to-wit:

THAT PORTION OF WEST 9TH STREET LOCATED BETWEEN 5TH AVENUE WEST AND 6TH AVENUE WEST IN THE CITY OF HORTON, BROWN COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, said request to vacate appears to be a reasonable request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HORTON, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the street located as follows, to-wit: **THAT PORTION OF WEST 9TH STREET LOCATED BETWEEN 5TH AVENUE WEST AND 6TH AVENUE WEST IN THE CITY OF HORTON, BROWN COUNTY, KANSAS** is hereby vacated pursuant to K.S.A. 14-423. The same shall revert to the owners of real estate adjacent thereto in proportion to the frontage of such real estate except as otherwise provided by K.S.A. 14-423. The City of Horton, Kansas hereby reserves to itself, the owners of lesser property rights and public utilities such rights-of-way and easements currently in existence on the above-described alley being vacated.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its publication unless one or more interested parties file a written protest before the expiration of such time. In the event such a protest is filed in the office of the city clerk, within such time the governing body shall set the same for hearing 10 days after the end of the 30 day period above mentioned. The hearing may be continued by the city, and at the conclusion thereof the governing body shall adopt a resolution confirming the vacation ordinance and the same shall then be filed with the county clerk and register of deeds as provided by K.S.A. 14-423, or in the event such resolution is not adopted, the vacation ordinance shall be void and of no effect.

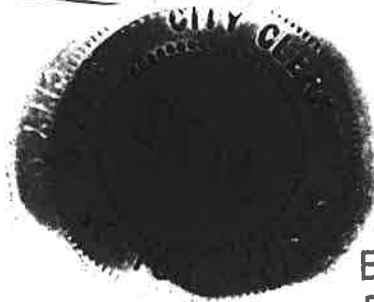

SECTION 2. That upon the taking effect of this Ordinance, the above zoning changes shall be entered and shown on the "Official Zoning Map" previously adopted by reference, and said official zoning map is hereby reincorporated as a part of the Zoning Regulation as amended.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption by the City Commission and publication in the official City newspaper.
