Estimates for an OCAF (rent) increase of two percent was used for income while actual increases in expenses were factored in where known. For example, health benefits are expected to increase by over 15% while other contract costs are increasing as well. The budget is

truly an estimate with a positive cash flow as required by the lender and investors.
