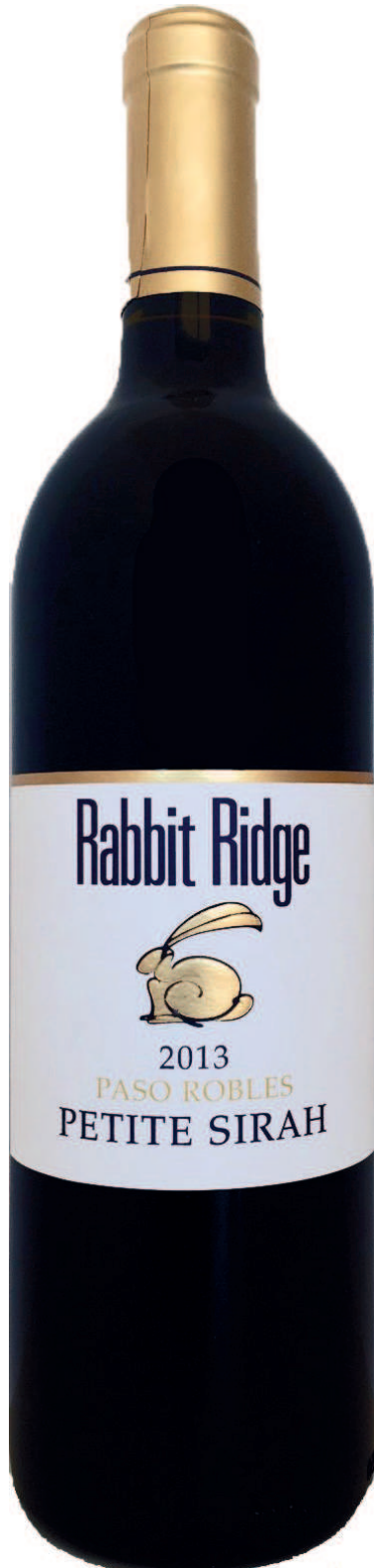

APPELLATION Paso Robles

GRAPE VARIETIES Petite Sirah

ALCOHOL 14.8%

VINIFICATION Hand picked into half ton bins. Cold soaked at 40 degrees for one to seven days. Extended skin contact for three to five weeks. Pumped over five to six times per day. Pressed and pumped to barrels. Aged 17 months in a combination of French and American oak.

TASTING Petite Sirah is a highly concentrated grape, exuding abundant color, structure and flavor. This is a massive wine with body, dense tannins and balanced acid. The nose shows blueberry fruit and vanilla from oak aging. The pallet includes dark fruit, to the tune of blackberry, black cherry, black plum and a touch of currant, mocha and spice. Splendid lingering long finish.
