

Green Knoll Penalty Area Guide

All markers red, yellow and environmental when in place shall determine the appropriate action to be taken. Keep in mind the USGA “Virtually Certainty” concept. If it is virtually certain that a ball can be in no other area than the penalty area, it is deemed to be in the penalty area.

Any area not delineated as a Penalty Area is to be considered in play for lost ball purposes.

#1 – Out of bounds on the right off tee they end about 150 yards out. Hit provisional or incur 2 shot penalty if ball is lost or OB. Out of bounds by Pitch and Putt on right side thru green.

Red stakes around back of green

#2 - No penalty areas – except the parking lot is OB.

#3 - Red stakes over green – OB if on the access road on the left.

#4 - No penalty areas (Yellow if you don't carry the stuff) – OB if on access road on left.

#5 - Creek is Yellow Stake.

Trees on right played as Red staked. Do best to identify correct point of entr.

#6 -- Water is yellow stake. Over green is all red staked.

#7 - Left side is red penalty area

#8 - First creek perpendicular is Yellow.

Creek parallel is red.

Middle creek is yellow

Creek by green is yellow

OB stakes over and directly behind green.

#9 - Right side off of tee is red stake. Do best to identify correct point of entry

No other penalty areas.

#10 - Red stakes over green (back of 15)

#11 - OB over back of green and left at the Pitch and Putt

#12 - Left of tree line is OB

#13 - OB on Left, Red stakes down right side, lateral after tree line at the creek.

#14 - No penalty areas (Yellow if you don't carry the stuff)

#15 - Per DGA Rules – not a penalty area until you reach the bend on the right – Red stakes to the end of the fairway after that.

Creek in front is yellow stake.

Over and left of green is red stake

#16- No penalty areas

#17- Left side tree line OB

#18 - Creek in front of tee Yellow stakes Weeds over creek and to the left in play
