About Holy Week

During Holy Week the focus is on the suffering and death of our Savior and the importance that it has for us and for our salvation.

Palm or Passion Sunday: This day commemorates the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem but then shifts the focus toward the suffering that Jesus endured on our behalf.

Maundy (Holy) Thursday: From the Latin word "mandatum", which means "command". The reference is to the Holy Gospel appointed for the day from John 13:34 – "A new command I give you: Love one another".

Good Friday: A solemn holy day commemorating the crucifixion of Jesus and his death at Calvary (Golgotha). Our Tenebrae Service includes the recitation of the Reproaches drawn from Micah 6:3-4. Responsively done between Pastor and the congregation, three times the question is asked: "What have I done to you, O My people?" and we respond with a plea for God's mercy.

Holy Saturday: Easter Vigil is a service constructed in four parts – light, Word, Baptism, and the Lord's Supper. It is the church's first celebration of the resurrection. It is one of Christianity's most ancient services, dating back to the 2nd century.

Easter Sunday: The Resurrection of Our Lord – He is Risen! He is Risen, Indeed! Alleluia!



Individual/small group communion is still being offered. Please telephone the church office if interested.


