1 Chronicles 16:34 — "O give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; For His lovingkindness is everlasting."

- A. Jesus expected gratitude... Luke 17:16–18 "16 and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks to Him. And he was a Samaritan. 17 Then Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But the nine—where are they? 18 "Was no one found who returned to give glory to God, except this foreigner?""
- B. The Apostle Paul commanded it. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-19 "¹⁶ Rejoice always; 17 pray without ceasing; 18 in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 19 Do not quench the Spirit;"
- C. Conclusion: GOD BELIEVES YOU SHOULD GIVE THANKS IN EVERY CIRCUMSTANCE IN YOUR LIFE IN CHRIST JESUS.
- **II.** How can we show proper thankfulness to God? (There are four significant aspects of thankfulness.)
 - A. Remembering what God has done. (v12)
 - **1 Chronicles 16:12** "Remember His wonderful deeds which He has done, His marvels and the judgments from His mouth,"

 - 2. **His marvels -Matthew 15:31** "So the crowd marveled as they saw the mute speaking, the crippled restored, and the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel."

- 3. **His judgments Ps 9:16** "The Lord has made Himself known; He has executed judgment. In the work of his own hands the wicked is snared. **-Job 5:12** "He frustrates the plotting of the shrewd, So that their hands cannot attain success. 13 "He captures the wise by their own shrewdness, And the advice of the cunning is quickly thwarted."
