Meeting Minutes

March 17, 2018

President Jan Frazier called the meeting to order at the Georgetown Public Library, Georgetown, Texas at 9:30 am. Members were welcomed and guest Julie Greenberg was introduced and welcomed.

Reports:

- A. Treasurer- Alora Johns – The treasurer’s report shows a current balance of \$6,364.38. Looking forward to upcoming expenses there is a projected balance in May of \$5764.38.
- B. Nominating – Vice-president Holly Read – There are 3 openings for officers in CTPS for next year. A program chair, webmaster and workshop chair are needed. Holly stressed that the offices will have lots of help and be a fun way to help CTPS have another successful year. Jeri Salter suggested that workshop artists can be located in the back of Pastel Journal Magazine.
- C. Exhibition Chair – Sue Kernan – The exhibition chair position is also being vacated next year. One chairman is needed to oversee the shows, with different members responsible for each show. Currently scheduled are shows at the Georgetown Library, St. David’s Hospital and at the CAC in Temple Texas. Julie Choate is currently chairing the St. David’s Hospital Show to be exhibited April 6th through June 1st. Application forms are due today. Currently there are 11 members registered. The hospital would like 35 pieces to exhibit.

For the April field trip bring your own water and refreshments will not be served. The May meeting will be held in the Baca Center in Round Rock. Bep will prepare coffee and 4 members were asked to sign up to bring refreshments.
- E. Workshop Chair – Jeri Salter – Dawn Emerson will be the artist conducting the workshop August 24 – 26. Dawn is a creative, fun and high energy person. She encourages looseness in painting. There are currently 12 people signed up for the workshop with space for 16. It will be held in Round Rock on Sam Bass Rd at the Texas Hall. There is easy access parking.
- F. Membership Chair – Ann Garrard introduced visitor Julie Greenberg. There were 22 members present today.
- G. Webmaster – Jane Frederick – Check with Jane if you need something posted on the website. They are still experiencing difficulties.
- H. Member Exhibitions – Several CTPS members had paintings that won awards in the APS Show. Jan Frazier received a first place in the Animals Division. Bob Douglas received a first and third place in Landscape. Nancy Lilly was awarded a second place in Still Life. Jeri Salter will be recognized in the July/August issue of Pastel Journal with an article and pictures about her work.
