- 3. Shipped quilts should be sent to c/o Sally Cole, 105 S. Railroad, P.O. Box 739, Council, Idaho 83612. Entries must arrive by June 17, 2019 (UPS, FED EX, USPS).**
- 4. Sales tables for folded quilts, arts and crafts are available. Items entered for sale are not voted on. For more information on consignment items for sale at the quilt show visit our web site.**
- 5. Each quilt must have its OWN entry form AND label sewn or pinned.**
- 6. Theme quilts must have a paragraph describing how the entry fits the category.**
- 7. If alternate arrangements are needed for drop-off or pickup call 208-253-4617.**

Make a 12 1/2 inch block using this year's challenge fabric. 2019 contest packets are available at the Council Library or call Sally at 208-253-4617. Packets are \$3.00. Each block entered must explain how it fits the 'Grandma's Kitchen' theme. Winners are determined by Viewer's Choice voting. 1st place winner will receive up to 12 blocks, remaining blocks will go to 2nd and possibly 3rd place winners depending on the number of entries.

Iron Quilt Trail

The Quilt Trail now includes 44 iron quilts on display in 4 Idaho counties. You can now find outdoor quilts in Midvale, Cambridge, Council, New Meadows, McCall, Riggins and Lucille.
