Holy Scripture

OLD TESTAMENT READING -1 Chronicles 4.9-11

Jabez was honored more than his brothers and his mother named him Jabez, saying, "Because I bore him in pain." Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, "Oh that you would bless me and enlarge my border, and that your hand might be with me, and that you would keep me from hurt and harm!" and God granted what he asked.

RESPONSIVE READING - Jonah 2.2-9

From inside the fish, Jonah prayed to the LORD his God,
In my distress I called to the LORD,
and He answered me.
From the belly of Sheol I called for help,
and You heard my voice.

For You cast me into the deep, into the heart of the
seas and the current swirled about me;
all Your breakers and waves swept over me.
[and] At this, I said, 'I have been banished from Your sight;
yet I will look once more toward Your holy temple.'

The waters engulfed me to take my life;
the watery depths closed around me;
the seaweed wrapped around my head.

GOSPEL LESSON - Matthew 6.5-15

"And whenever you pray, do not be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, so that they may be seen by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward. But whenever you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you. "When you are praying, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do; for they think that they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him.

"Pray then in this way: Our Father in heaven,
hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come.
Your will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us
our debts as we also have forgiven our debtors;
and lead us not into temptation but rescue us
from evil.

For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you; but if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

This is the Word of the Lord!
