Purpose:

To build capacity for Thessalon First Nation and provide an interested First Nation Band Member with experience, which may lead to future education/training and/or employment in the Forest Industry/Lands Management.

Scope:

This position will support and assist the Senior Registered Professional Forester (RPF) in monitoring salvage operations without having to sacrifice quality due to budget limitations, identifying and monitoring any invasive species or diseases affecting the forest and ecosystem, determining where, if any, sensitive area exist and what the best mitigation efforts are to implement, and analyzing newly collected data from TFN and identifying/interpreting any potential, or ongoing concerns, sensitivities, and new developments, etc. Please keep in mind that this position will be supported by the Senior Registered Professional Forester (RPF) and the Geographic Information System Specialist (GIS).

This position will work within the Lands Department of TFN.
