FROM THE PRESIDENT





As you look at the ANASAZI 2017 calendar, there are a couple of items that need to be pointed out and explained:

- The February rally in Yuma at Fortuna de Oro. The park has been reserved from February 2 to February 8th. This was done to accommodate the distance/travel time to Yuma, AZ. The hosts for this rally will be responsible only for the normal weekend -- February 3 through February 5th. If they want to do anything for February 2nd that will be their choice.
