We also wanted to fill you in on how things are going at Camp. As you may have suspected, Arrah Wanna is essentially "closed" through May, and possibly June, as our ministry is all about bringing groups of people together in this beautiful place. That means that in order to survive this time, we have TEMPORARILY laid off ALL employees and shut down as much of our operating systems as possible. Sean, Shannon & Corey continue to live on camp and take care of basic up-keep and essentials, while myself and others volunteer from home in order to stay up-to-date on financial resources and stay in touch with our supporters. We have submitted our application for the *Paycheck Protection Program*, and continue to seek out other financial resources. It is our hope that enough money



comes in that we can re-hire some employees and do some projects while camp is empty. We continue to meet weekly as a staff via virtual platforms and find encouragement through praying with one another.

Although we are missing our campers and guests, we have found hope and renewal in the quiet, too! This has made it possible to focus more on the things that often get pushed to the side this time of year— catching up with secondary administrative tasks, improving our interactive social media presence, spending time planning for when camp re-opens, and truly taking time to slow down and meditate on what the Great Creator has already blessed us with – WHICH IS A LOT!



Like many of you, we wonder what the future will look like after the stay-at-home orders are lifted, but we have faith that the Lord truly is creating beauty out of the disaster and confusion. We have a sense of peace in God's promises to continue work here at Arrah Wanna, so now is not the time to end this adventure!
