Mary A. Wiechert, age 95 of Standish (formerly of Bay Port and Caseville), passed away Tuesday, March 17 at Tolfree Hospital in West Branch.

She was born in Portland, Connecticut on May 5, 1902, the daughter of the late Adam and Anna (Williams) Camp. On February 2, 1921 she was united in marriage to Wilfred Frederick Wiechert in Caro. He preceded her in death on June 6, 1995.
