

HSCS DECISION TREE

TIER I: In Person Instruction

No confirmed cases COVID 19 are present in the school community.

Cohort model: Students will experience education within classroom cohorts.

Sanitation practices of classrooms, classroom materials, bathrooms and common spaces exist.

Students social distance and wear face coverings as appropriate and possible.
Adults social distance and wear face coverings.

Screening protocols in place for all faculty staff, students and visitors

Building open to all students.

TIER II: Hybrid- Quarantining a Cohort

Confirmed case(s) present in single cohort.

Cohort with confirmed case will transfer to remote learning for the duration of quarantine as advised by local health officials. If prolonged illness is present in cohort then quarantine lasts for at least two weeks after onset of symptoms.

The rest of the school will continue with Tier I procedures.

Enhanced sanitation to the cohort classroom will take place after the confirmed case.

Upon return Cohort will resume Tier I procedures.

If more than one cohort has a confirmed case, move to Tier III.

TIER III: Fully Remote Education

Confirmed case(s) in more than one cohort or as directed by govt. officials.

Entire school community will transfer to remote education.

School will remain in remote education for 2 days after the confirmed cases test negative.

Enhanced sanitation of entire school building will take place.

Upon return to school building school community will resume Tier I.
