I. The new creation of God will proceed the destruction of the old.

Revelation 21:1–2 — "¹ Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer any sea. ² And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband.

- A. God will make a new heaven and a new earth.
- B. The new Heavens and the new Earth will have a capital city.
 - 1. The new Jerusalem already exists according to **Hebrews** 12:22
- II. There will be a new reality for those who have persevered in following Christ.

Revelation 21:3 — "³ And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them,"

A. God's dwelling place will be among us.

- 1. No long will people look up to where God's throne is. They will pan their eyes from where they stand and say God is with us.
- 2. We shall be His people and He shall be our God.

B. God will eliminate all suffering of every kind.

Revelation 21:4 — "⁴ and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away.""

- 1. Tears will have no reason to be shed.
- 2. Death will no longer exist.
- 3. Sadness and pain will vanish forever.

C. God seals the coming of the new creation with his absolute word.

Revelation 21:5–6 — "⁵ And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." And He said, "Write, for these **words are faithful and true**." ⁶ Then He said to me, "It is done. I am **the Alpha and the Omega**, the beginning and the end. I will give to the one who thirsts from the spring of the water of life without cost."
