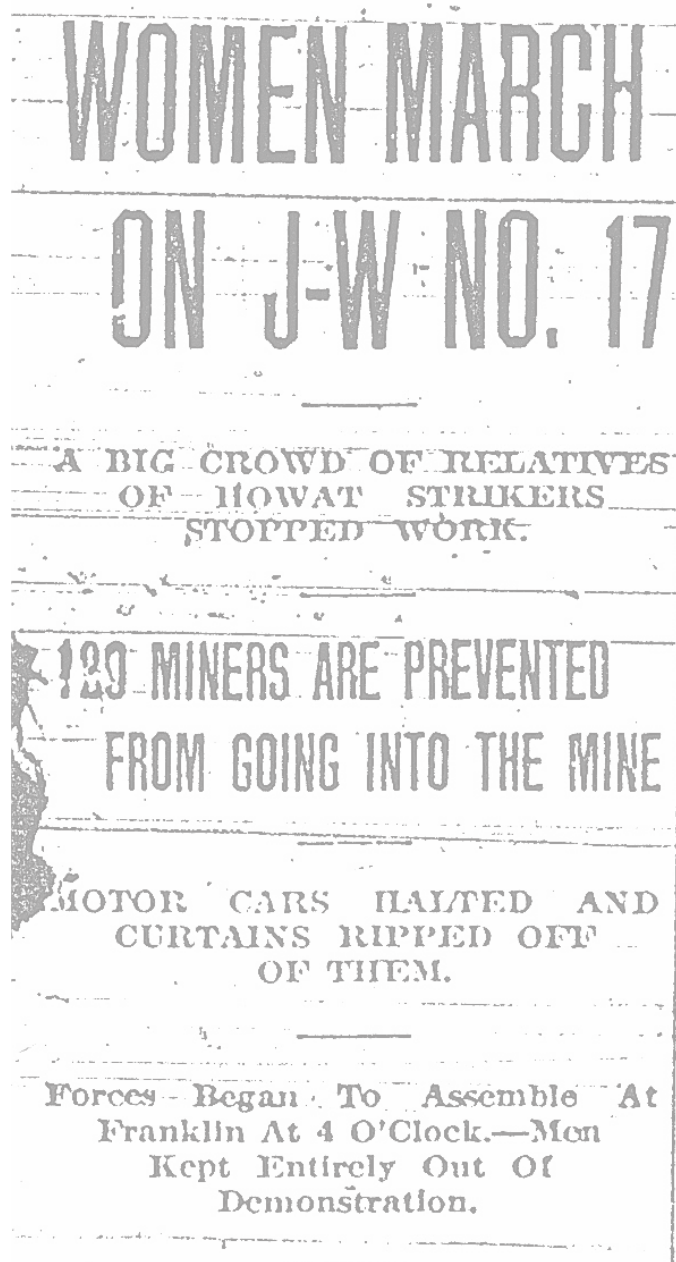


The Amazon Army

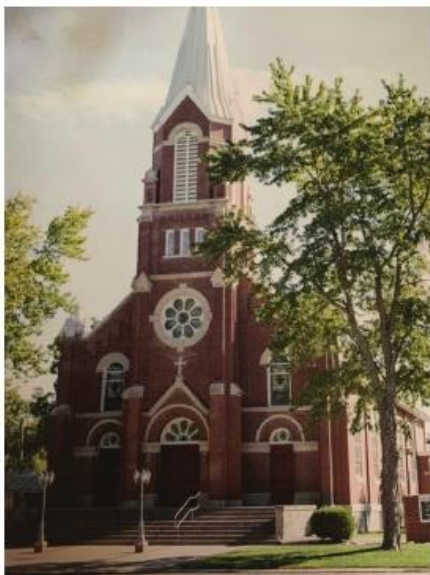

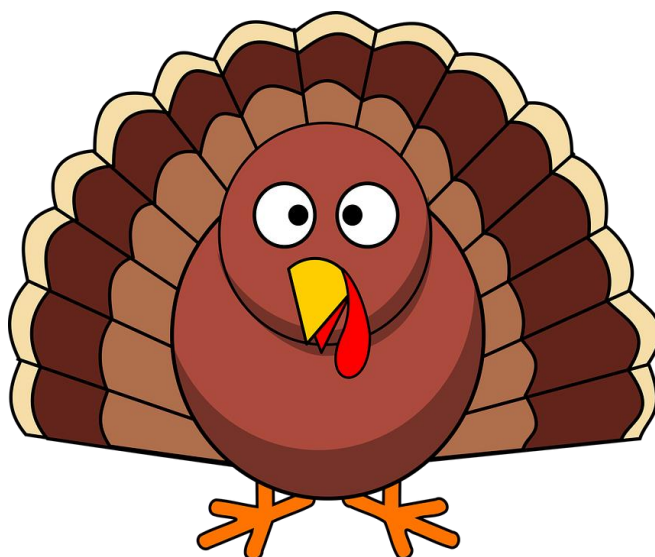
