# Kittitas County Prehospital Care Protocols

Subject: ADENOSINE (ADENOCARD, LYPHOMED)

## **ACTION:**

Transient slowing of sinus rate and AV nodal conduction.

# **INDICATIONS:**

Acute Termination of PSVT. Differentiating PSVT with aberration from V-Tach.

# **CONTRAINDICATIONS:**

None

#### **PRECAUTIONS:**

Needs to be administered Rapid IV bolus. Because half-life is measured in seconds PSVT may be likely to re-occur.

# SIDE EFFECTS:

May cause high degree transient AV nodal block, Bradycardia, PVC's (short lived).

### DOSAGE:

<u>6 mg</u> rapid IV push. Flush line with normal saline. <u>If no change within 1-2 minutes -> 12 mg rapid IV push</u>.

# **ROUTE:**

Rapid IV bolus only

## **PEDIATRIC DOSE:**

<u>37.5 ug/kg</u> successively in increments until a total of 350 ug/kg is reached.
