### Ad Board Report

The Pastor has suggested a new mission / vision statement for Bethany, which would become effective at the start of 2018. From a choice of two similar versions, the Board voted to approve the following – "Renewing the church to change the world."

The slow but steady decline in the number of Bethany members available to conduct the official work of the church is leading the Board to reconsider an alternative minimum structure that would streamline governance. A class is soon to be offered on how that system works. And it must be noted that recent rulings have made it mandatory that church leadership attend such a class before it can switch to such a method of operations.

The Pastor is involved in the Wesley Covenant Association, which is a nation-wide group of Methodist pastors who are trying to focus on future direction with special regard to both the primacy of the Bible and the rules and regulations of the Book of Discipline. It's intended to provide churches with options in the wake of the decisions to come from General Conference in the next few years with regard to sexual orientation vis-à-vis individual church standings on such matters. Our choices will turn on what church we want to be in the future in terms of our stances on gay marriage, LGBTQ membership / leadership, and the like. The Board is asked to consider whether it wants more information on this initiative.

### Trustees' Report.....

Since the last newsletter, the new kitchen in the church has been inspected and approved by the Department of Agriculture and the heating systems in the church, Parish House, and the parsonage have been cleaned, inspected and tested to make sure they were operating well before the winter heating season.

After receiving and reviewing four proposals for draperies and/or blinds for the Parish House, the Trustees approved the proposal from The Barn Fabric Center in Williamsport. The chosen proposal was for drapes and sheers for all windows with simple tiebacks to keep them open when desired. Due to the seamstress' other commitments, the new drapes probably won't be installed until after the holidays.

As the McNeals settled into the parsonage, they made note of some changes to the electrical system, which they felt would make the house more comfortable and safe for them. Among the requests was additional exterior lighting and some changes to the lighting in the basement. At a recent meeting, the Trustees approved a proposal from T-Ross Brothers to complete the work. Hopefully the project will be completed before the holidays.


