Welcome to Camp Oginali! We are so happy you will be joining us. It's sure to be a summer filled with friendship, adventure and fun! Please be sure to completely fill out and sign both sides of the enclosed registration forms. Scan them in and e-mail them back to Shellie@campoginali.com

Although each day is unique and flexible, a typical day will progress with a natural rhythm and balance between cooperative energetic activities and personal creative time. Each day will begin with a nature walk. Each week we will have a new theme and the activities, crafts, games, and stories for the week will all tie into the theme. A typical day may look like this:

9:00 - 10:00 Hike and Explore
10:00 - 10:30 Snack
10:30 – 11:30 Main Craft or Activity
11:30 - 12:00 Gardening or Games
12:00 - 12:30 Lunch
12:30 – 12:50 Story Time
12:50 – 1:30 Art
1:30 - 2:00 Snack and Water Play
2:00 - 3:00 Free Play

We will depart for our morning walk each day at 9:10. Please be sure to arrive on time. If you are running late and we have already left for our walk, please walk with your child down the nature trail and come join us.

What to Bring:

Lunch: All campers need to bring a lunch and afternoon snack from home. Please try to keep lunches healthy and avoid candies or too much sugar!

Snacks: Camp Oginali will provide healthy (95% organic) snacks each morning. Snacks may include fresh veggies, rice with almonds, oatmeal with maple syrup, fresh baked bread, etc. Please be sure to mark any food allergies your child may have on the registration form. Campers must bring a healthy afternoon snack from home.

Play Clothes: Half the fun of summer is getting dirty! Be prepared to get muddy! Please be sure your child is wearing appropriate footwear. We will be doing LOTS of walking, running, and playing. Each morning will begin with a nature walk through the wetlands and along the creek. We will be walking every day - RAIN OR SHINE! Please be sure your child has a raincoat, rain hat, and mud-sloshing boots on rainy or questionable days. On the same note, the Colorado sun can be brutal. All children must bring their own sunscreen AND a sunhat. We will also be wading in the creek or pond in the afternoons to cool off. All children must have water shoes to enter the water. Keens, Chacos, or old sneakers are great. Please no flip-flops or Crocs as these tend to fall off and float away! Each child will have their own cubby for the session. If you'd like you may leave rain gear and sunscreen at camp, rather than packing it up every morning.

Cancellation Policy:
