

NELSON "JAKE" HOLLAND

1922 - 1988

Nelson "Jake" Holland, 66 of Sebewaing, passed away Tuesday, Nov. 8 at Bay Medical Center, Bay City, following a brief illness.

He was born in Sebewaing Township on May 12, 1922, son of Aaron and Helen (Rueger) Holland. A lifetime farmer in the Sebewaing Area, Mr. Holland married the former Ilene Fritz on Nov. 28, 1947 and was employed for 28 years with the Michigan Sugar Company prior to his retirement in 1972.

Mr. Holland was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church of Kilmanagh, a U.S. Navy veteran of World War II and a life member of American Legion Post #293 of Sebewaing.
