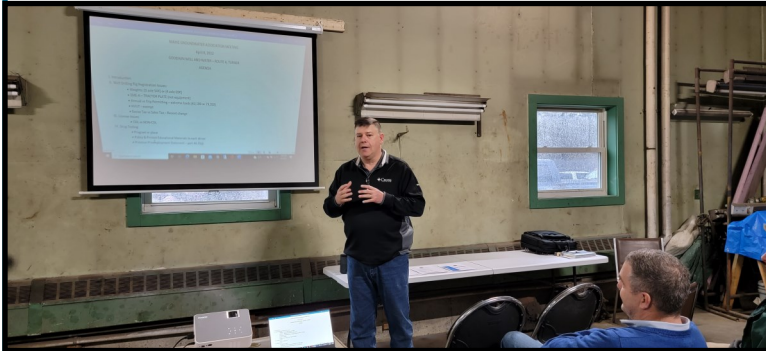

# MGWA Director's Minutes April 11, 2022

## Maine Ground Water Association Director's Meeting April 11, 2022 Via Zoom

The MGWA Director's Meeting was called to order by President Jesse Goodwin at 7:09 p.m. with the following present: Justin Lanphier, Mitch Woodbury, Susan Smith, Scott Abbotts, Scott Hodgdon, Brian Streeter, Glenn Dyer, and Noah Rolfe.

Minutes: A motion by Brian Streeter and seconded by Justin Lanphier to approve the March 14, 2022, Director's Meeting minutes was unanimously approved with the following correction, delete duplicate Director's name Brian Streeter.

Treasurers Report: A motion by Scott Hodgdon and seconded by Justin Lanphier to approve the Treasurer's Report was unanimously approved.

Old Business: Discussion on drill rigs being overweight. Drill rigs are typically low milage. Most drill rigs are not in compliance. Scott Abbotts did some online research and found out how other states register drill rigs. Jesse Goodwin spoke with State Senator Jeff Timberlake. We should call our local state legislators to see if they can help us. We may be able to get a rule change or get a bill sponsored, but not until they're back in session. Jesse Goodwin formed a committee to work on overweight issue, consisting of Justin Lanphier, Scott Abbotts, Noah Rolfe, Scott Hodgdon, Jesse Goodwin, and Susan Smith. Committee will meet on April 25, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. Via Zoom.

New Business: Scott Hodgdon reported a person is emailing him that wants to speak at one of our meetings for free. Scott Abbotts looked at the website and some director's thought it might be spam.
