## ASCENSION OF THE LORD May 28/29

Departures can be painful, none more than the mysterious finality of a soul's departure from this life. This weekend's Feast of the Ascension is a peek behind that curtain and what the believer sees is life, fulfillment, and hope. The disciples witnessed the Lord go

away. But they were not sad. Saint Luke relates that the disciples were full of joy upon returning to Jerusalem after witnessing Jesus' Ascension on the Mount of Olives. Jesus had gone away but had not died. He had departed but was fully alive. Christ showed that there was an alternative path, a different way of leaving our time and space.

It reminds us that death and suffering and loss are painful but not the end and we know now that we are meant to live forever in the Father's house in heaven.

Today the Church asks us to gaze up at the Ascension and to say, "Here I am too, here is my body restored, in all the resplendent glory of my baptism." No longer do we need to worry about our origins. We now must reflect upon our destination-where we are going. Today we marvel at the spectacle of Jesus Christ ascending to heaven and to home. The Ascension is about what comes next. It teaches us that it is the reunion with God that makes us great and makes us happy.
