

This Permit is being issued based on the following conditions being met.

- 1. Prevailing winds at the time of burning are away from the major portion of the area's population and away from any major throughfare.
- 2. The location of the burn is at least 1,000 feet from any occupied structure.
- 3. The amount of dirt on or in the material being burned is minimized.
- Heavy oil, asphaltic materials, items containing natural or synthetic rubber, or any material other than plant growth are not being burned; and
- 5. No more than one pile 60 feet, or equivalent, is being burned within a 9-acre area at one time.
- 6. Use of fans (Air Curtain Destructor) may be allowed at the discretion of the fire Official. If a fan(s) is used, the "Air Curtain Destructor regulations" prepared by the NGA Regional EPD must be followed. A copy of this document is on file at the Fire Official's Office.
- 7. The area must be attended constantly by a competant person until the fire is extinguished. Such person should have a supply of water or other extinguishing equipment available for use.
- 8. A copy of the deed must be attached to the application.
- These conditions must be met until the fire is extinguished.

Note: Violation(s) of this approved Burn Permit are subject to full disciplinary actions which include revoking permit and /or fine(s) which have been set forth by the Commission authorizing the conditions of this permit.
