Getting started is easy. Most first-time flyers opt for a "RTF" (Ready To Fly) airplane. There are many of these stable, easy to fly "Trainers" which are perfect for beginners.

Our instructors use the "Buddy Box" method where the two radios are linked together. The instructor can take control at any time. Mastering take-off, basic flight, and landing should not take too long. Once you are a safe and competent flyer you will be presented with your Solo Flight Certificate.

The Club holds events throughout the year including our monthly meeting, summer evening social flying, Fun Fly competitions, family picnic, Swap Meet, and an Open House.

Our 2025 Open House will be Saturday June 14, weather permitting.

The rain/wind delay date is Sunday June 15, depending upon the weather forecast. This decision will be made by noon on Friday, June 13.
