UPDATED INFORMATION FOR SCOUTS OF TROOP 78

GETTING THERE:

Due to the Covid pandemic, each Scout will have to provide their own transportation.

Plan to arrive at Camp Ware promptly at 8:00 AM on Saturday morning.

Pick up time on Saturday afternoon at Camp Ware be at 4:30 PM.

Directions to Camp Ware from the north: Follow US 1 South to PA 272 North at the Nottingham exit, after exiting, turn right on to PA-272 North and follow for 2.6 miles to a slight left on Kirks Mill Road, then in 3.8 miles take a slight left on Little Britain Rd., in 0.2 miles take a left onto Balance Meeting Rd., this will merge with Jubilee Road, follow Jubilee Rd. for 1.6 miles until it enters Camp Ware.

PREPARATION:

Each attendee is expected to attend a Klondike preparation meeting on Friday February 12 from 7:00PM to 8:30PM at the cabin (no uniforms). You will be decorating your Klondike sleds, and making other preparations.

Patrol leaders are responsible for bringing patrol supplies (per the list provided) and making sure your “dog” sled is in good repair.

Patrol Needs: Klondike Sled, 2 - Six-foot staves, Patrol first aid kit, Blanket/tarp, Compass, Natural fire building materials, fire starters, 10 feet of rope, Camaraderie!
