1927 - 1999

Raymond W Bruderick, age 72, of Elkton died Tuesday morning, October 12, 1999 at his home.

He was born February 5, 1927 in Minden City, son of the late Raymond and Frances (Regentin) Bruderick. He graduated from Minden City High School, Class of 45 and served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict.
