

AN ORDINANCE SETTING OUT TRAFFIC REGULATIONS
AND PROVIDING PENALTIES

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Town to regulate traffic, including parking, within the Town of Cloverdale, and

WHEREAS, I.C. 9-4-1-28 establishes guidelines for the development of a system of traffic regulation by the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Cloverdale that the following rules and regulations be adopted:

A. Parking Regulations

At any time it shall be unlawful to permit any vehicle to stand in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a policeman or traffic control device:

1. In any intersection.
2. In a crosswalk.
3. Upon any bridge or viaduct, or the approach thereto.
4. Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty feet of a point of the curb immediately opposite the end of a safety zone.
5. Within thirty feet of a traffic signal, beacon, or sign on the approaching side.
6. Within twenty feet of any intersection or crosswalk.
7. At any place where the standing of a vehicle will reduce the usable width of the roadway for moving traffic to less than eighteen feet.
8. Within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant.
9. At any place where by vehicle would block the use of a driveway.
10. Within fifty feet of the nearest rail of a railroad grade crossing.
11. Within twenty feet of the driveway entrance to any fire department station and on the side of the street opposite the entrance to any such station within seventy five feet of such entrance when properly sign posted.
12. On any sidewalk or parkway.
13. At any place where official signs prohibit parking.
14. At any place where the curb has been painted yellow by the town.
15. Parking spaces for mobility handicapped persons. It shall be unlawful for any person without a mobility handicap or not using a wheelchair to park in any space reserved for such handicapped persons; provide, however, that a driver of a vehicle used in transporting such handicapped persons may park in such spaces.
16. A violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of \$5.00 for parking violations or \$10.00 fine if such parking restricts traffic.

B. Stop Sign and Thoroughfare Designation

The following streets shall be designated as "one-way" or "thoroughfares;" and any vehicle entering a through street shall come to a full stop before proceeding onto such highway or thoroughfare.

1. As through highway:
Lafayette St., running north and south, except for that Robert Weist Rd. and Market Street, which has stop signs for that traffic;
Grant Street, north and south, except for Burma Road, which has stop signs at that location for that direction;
West Street, running north and south.

2. It shall be a violation of this ordinance to fail to "stop" before crossing or entering a thoroughfare at such locations as are marked by stop signs.
3. A violation of this ordinance by failing to stop shall be punishable by a fine of \$20.00.

C. Speed Limits

1. The following maximum allowable speeds shall be established:

School Zone as identified by appropriate signs	20 mph
Residential Areas as identified and posted	30 mph
Speed Limits on all other streets within the Corporate limits shall be	30 mph
2. Violation of speeding ordinance shall be subject to a fine as follows:	
Speeding in School Zone	\$20.00
Speeding in other areas	\$20.00
2nd Offense in calendar year	\$25.00

D. The Town Board by this ordinance hereby establishes a minimum fee of \$5.00 for supplying an accident report to any persons, plus additional charges of \$1.00 per page if the report requested is more than two (2) pages.

E. Fines may be paid by depositing with the Clerk the sum due and executing a waiver as to right to trial. In event of denial, see Violations Ordinance.

F. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its publication.

G. This Ordinance shall repeal and supercede Ordinance 1983-5, An Ordinance Establishing Speed Limits, Regulating the Operation of Motor Vehicles in the Town of Cloverdale, Classifying Traffic Offenses and Providing Penalties for the Violation Thereof.
