As always an open session to hear from the members was held and valuable insight and information was heard. All matters and concerns were noted, respected, and taken seriously.

- One new Board member was appointed, Director Angelo Stamis
- The board discussed future upgrades to the security of RBA.
- The Newsletter Committee was reorganized: Director Angelo Stamis was appointed chair.
- The Security Committee was reorganized: Director Angelo Stamis was appointed Chair and is looking for input and volunteers from members to sit on committee.
- The next Board of Directors will be held on January 21, 2021 at 6:00 PM
- Separate notices will be sent as to the location of meeting.

## ***Other RBA Business:***

The Community is in the middle of a major Security System upgrade, around the middle of January 2021 there will be the installation of Transponders onto the Resident Entry gate and new RFID Tags will be issued to all residents.

Triton Security will co-ordinate the installation of the Radio Frequency Tags onto the headlight of vehicles.

The Resident side entry will be equipped with license plate cameras and all visitors will be provided with a computer-generated printed pass which will be stored in the data base of the computer.

The Association will replace all of the existing cameras with new updated models and new DVR's plus monitors.

These security system upgrades are being done in stages and should be fully operational in January 2021

## Water Smart Guidelines

- Assigned watering days are mandatory for all customers. Running your landscape irrigation system outside your assigned days is water waste and may result in a water-waste fee or citation.
- It's always a good idea to water less often than permitted and increase the schedule only if your landscape needs more water.
- Winter from November 01, 2020 through to February 28, 2021 landscape watering is one **day a week**, Watering group C which falls onto Wednesdays only. Sprinkler watering on Sunday is prohibited
