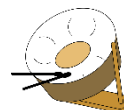
Dominican Republic

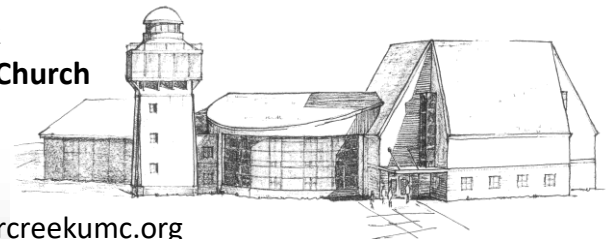
Fall Schedules
