21 22 23	Ms. Roecks read out loud the Resolution 15-06, to put the replacement excess levy on the ballot for November, 2015.
24 25 26 27	Mr. Thompson explained that there is nothing new to this levy request, it's an exact replacement from last year.
28 29 30	Resident Mary Lou Benson asked if it can be increased next year. Mrs. Benson suggested making tax payers aware as soon as possible if there is an increase for next year's resolution regarding the fire levy.
31 32	Mr. Thompson suggested the council needs to address next year's increase after this election.
32 33 34	Mr. Tollefson wants the fire department's help in trying to make financial decisions.
35 36 37	Fire Chief Stan Seehorn asked for the levy's annual revenue amount which the Mayor told him is \$12,500.00.
38 39	Resident Ivan Wilmschen asked Mr. Seehorn how much money Fire District 11 has.
40 41 42	Mr. Seehorn said it is approximately \$359,000.00, much of which is earmarked for a satellite station in the district.
43 44 45	Ms. Roecks says well will be in a better situation in 2015 due to the agreement made with the district; utilities being split with the district and the increase in rent at the Fire Department.
46 47	Mr. Wilmschen asked if all the vehicles in the compound are in working condition and are being used.
48 49	Mr. Seehorn says that all vehicles are being used.
50 51	There being no other public comment, Ms. Roecks closed the public hearing.
52 53	Ms. Roecks opened the regular council meeting.
54 55 56	Mr. Thompson made a motion to adopt Resolution 15-06. Mr. Stevenson seconded the motion. Motion carried.
