## National Membership Requirements for Canadian Chapters:

Alpha Phi Sigma has reviewed the grading scales of a cross section of colleges and universities in Canada, and determined that the equivalent of a 3.2 GPA (US Standard) is equivalent to a 75% in Canada. Therefore the minimum requirements for baccalaureate applicants attending Canadian institutions are: 75% cumulative courses; 75% in criminal justice (or related fields) courses; and must have completed at least four criminal justice (or related fields) courses.

## Chapter Membership Requirements:

Chapters are allowed to increase the membership requirements and fees. It is suggested before completing the application, the student contact the chapter advisor at the institution. The chapter directory can be found on our website at:

Under no circumstances, can chapters accept or lower the minimum requirements of National Headquarters.

## Application Process

- ✚ Applications **MUST** be typed. Applications which are handwritten will be returned. All fields must be completed, unless listed as “optional”
- ✚ Completed applications must be submitted to the chapter advisor or assistant chapter advisor, for verification and signature.
- ✚ Chapter advisor or assistant chapter advisor shall mail application and US\$70.00 one time National membership fee to Alpha Phi Sigma National Headquarters.
