## May 28, 2019 RICHWOOD VILLAGE COUNCIL

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the regular meeting of the Richwood Village Council was called to order by Mayor Scott Jerew, May 28, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Jerew swore in Von Beal as a new Council Member.

He also noted that we are to be awarded a \$23,478.00 Grant for an ADA compliant boat dock.

The Administration Report was presented to Council.

Mayor Jerew stated that Jason Wills has been notified he needs to be working on Dudley Circle. Monte Asher will reach out to Mr. Wills.

Laurie Eliot stated the the new tornado siren is up and running.

There was a brief discussion of replacing the K-9.
