"The highway system for ships"

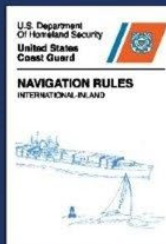
PLAY IT SAFE
ALWAYS GO
ASTERN

- Avoid the TSS when not using it
- The size and speed of large ships using the lanes can be deceiving
- Large ships may have a hard time seeing you
- Wakes from large ships can be hazardous

DO NOT IMPEDE
power driven ships
following the lanes
Sailing vessels and craft less than 65 ft in length must give way and **CLEAR THE LANE** to ensure safe navigation
