80th FRA and 78th FRA Auxiliary 2024 East Coast Regional Convention (ECRC)

This year's ECRC was held in Williamsburg, VA at the Fort Magruder Hotel and Conference Center and hosted by Special Committee chaired by Shipmate PREPC Paul Phelps (Br. 40). Our Branch delegates Shipmates President PRPEC Randy Phillipp, PNC Paul Gunther, RSEC Thomas Rauch, and Michael Tovornik were all in attendance.

On Wednesday, September 11, 2024 at 1400, Opening Ceremonies were held with the Virginia Department of Veterans Services Commissioner Chuck Zingler as the Keynote Speaker. Later that night there was a Welcome Aboard Party held with music and games

On Thursday, September 12, 2024 at 0900 the FRA Business Session was called to order. Reports of the Regional Officers, President (Robert Oliveira), Vice President (Valerie Toulotte), Secretary (Thomas Rauch), Treasurer (Philip Stone) and Jr. PRPEC (Gabriel Falu) were read. The State and National Legislative Representatives from VA, NC, and National Headquarters reported on Veteran programs and laws that pertained to their state or the Nation as a whole. There were no reports for DE, MD, and DC.

Next on the agenda was the Reports of the Standing Committees. This is where the results of the Regional Branches' submissions for the various committees were revealed. Our Branch in Group IV placed 1st for Public Relations and Youth Activities, 2nd for Hospitals, Welfare, Rehabilitation, and 3rd for Americanism/Patriotism. For Veterans Service Officer and VA Voluntary Service, we had no report. Shipmates Rauch and Kaider were selected as Shipmate of the Year for Public Relations and Youth Activities, respectively. The Budget & Finance and Audit Committees conducted their reports as well. Next was the Bylaws & Rules committee, all the bylaw resolutions that were listed on the August Newsletter were approved and for the adoption of the "Electronic Regional Convention" Standing Rule there was a committee created to establish a platform and rules for having meetings on-line.

The Time & Place committee reported that Branch 99 will host the 2025 Mid-Year Meeting (MYM) and there were no Branch submissions to host the 2025 ECRC, 2026 MYM or 2026 ECRC. After discussion, the following was agreed upon for hosting these events: 2025 ECRC, Branches 99 and 166; 2026 MYM, Branch/Unit 40; 2026 ECRC, ECR Red/Gray Hats Ad Hoc Committee with Shipmate PRPEC Paul Phelps as Chair.

Under New Business there were seven Branches that petition to operate under 1216(a) and were approved for ratification. Then the 2024-2025 Elections of Regional Officers were held. The following officers were elected:
