Leader: We pray for unity and wholeness in the body of Christ; for all those who do works of charity in this community; and for all who live out their baptismal calling in faithful and humble service. Hear us, O God.

Cong.: Your mercy is great.

Leader: We give you thanks, Oh God, for all the saints who have shared your bread of life and cup of salvation, and who now dwell in your everlasting embrace of love. Bring us, also with them, to the eternal joys of the paschal feast. Hear us, O God.

Cong.: Your mercy is great.

Leader: Hear us according to your steadfast love, O God, and by your great compassion, bring us at last to own rebirth and resurrection in Jesus Christ our Lord.
