DESCRIPTION: Rare and hard to find Ernie Root target bow. The Pendulus Supreme was Root's top-of-the-line bow. In 1961 it sold for \$150 (which would be \$1,285.00 in 2019 inflation-adjusted dollars).

The good: No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No stress lines or crazing. Still a shooter.

The bad: A few nicks, dings, scratches and scuffs here and there. A half dozen filled screw holes; some readily visible, some barely perceptible. A stabilizer insert was added. Standard yellowing of the limb varnish. There is also a stress line in the grip of the riser that leads up to the shelf. Some blemishes and stains.

Note: The limbs are white, but look bluish in some of the photos.
