

Job Posting: Wastewater Trmt Plant Operations Supervisor

Position: Wastewater Treatment Plant Operations Supervisor

Duties: The WWTP Operations Supervisor supervises the functions of the Division of Water Reclamation, to optimize the performance of an advanced water reclamation facility on a continuous basis. The incumbent works under the general direction of the WWT Administrator and has primary responsibility for the operation and maintenance of all treatment facilities on a 24-hour, around the clock basis and serves as the backup/support to the other Treatment Plant Operations Supervisor. Incumbent has considerable latitude in making process control adjustments, daily operating decisions and employee assignments. Maintains inventory of parts and supplies and assures that all plant equipment is maintained; assists in the development of equipment specifications, material requirements, and cost estimates. Responsibilities include interviewing, hiring, and training employees, planning, assigning and directing work; appraising performance, rewarding and disciplining employees, addressing complaints and resolving problems. The incumbent must maintain a thorough knowledge of administrative policies and procedures, standard operating procedures/guidelines.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Wastewater Technology, Environmental Science, or a closely related field AND 5 years of experience in the operation and maintenance of a wastewater facility. Three of the 5 years must be in a supervisory capacity OR

Associate's Degree in Engineering, Wastewater Technology, Environmental Science, or a closely related field AND 10 years of experience in the operation and maintenance of a wastewater facility. Five of the 10 years must be in a supervisory capacity OR

Graduation from High School (or G.E.D.) AND 15 years of experience in the operation and maintenance of a wastewater facility. Eight of the 15 years must be in a supervisory capacity.

Requirements: Must possess a driver's license at the time of appointment and maintain thereafter as a term and condition of employment. Must possess a valid Ohio EPA Wastewater Class III license at the time of application. Final appointment is contingent upon passing a job-related medical examination, including drug screen and providing documentary evidence of Employment Authorization and Identity required by the Immigration and Nationality Act.
