Reports:

Recording Secretary: Meeting minutes from the October council meeting were read prior to the meeting by members. Motion to accept the minutes was made by Marty Hoeft, 2nd Dan Mathews. MC. Special meeting minutes from October 15th were read. Motion to accept minutes was made by Ann Diekman, 2nd Robin Hansen. MC.

Secretary Report: Oak Harbor Apple Fest

Royalty Court would like to use the hall on Saturday, February 10th for a Princess Tea Party. Instead of paying a fee they would offer community service to the church. Robin Hansen made a motion to allow the Oak Harbor Apple Fest Royalty court to use our hall in exchange for community service. 2nd Ann Diekman. MC.

Financial Report: Financial Report was reviewed. Motion to accept financial report was made by Dan Gahler 2nd John Bast MC.

Last year we committed \$2500 to Northwest Ohio Association. The Association would like us to meet and/or exceed that donation. Discussion held. Steve Turnow made a motion to continue to meet our donation of \$2500 to the Northwest Ohio Association. 2nd Marty Hoeft. MC.

Kyle would like to rejoin the group, Excellence in Ministry, with other local pastors. The yearly membership fee is \$250. Funds will come from continuing education allowance.

Pastor Report:

For the month of October - one wedding, one funeral, four home visits and no hospital visits Kyle completed the mandatory Northwest Ohio Association boundary training.

On Sunday November 5th, seventeen new members were brought in to the church. Others have since approached Kyle wanting to join our church. Kyle still planning on surgery in mid-January.

- Snow Removal – three bids received, reviewed and discussion held. John Bast made a motion to hire Don Kreager for snow removal. 2nd Steve Turnow, MC.

New Business:

- Ellis Ministries would like to have a Women's Conference on Saturday January 6th here at Trinity. Will be held 8:30am -2pm which would include a free time of worship, lunch & t-shirt. Event will be open to 100 people. Analisa Turnow will give an announcement at worship on Sunday, November 19th.
- Health Insurance
 - We paid \$17,800 Next year proposed to go up to \$25,398 thru United Church of Christ
 - Out of budget this year, budget committee do not feel we can afford
 - Proposal to keep Kyle on UCC Plan A which will be \$11, 871 for the year (\$2967.75 per quarter)
 - Jackie will be \$1450 for the year under the Affordable Care Act & Children will be free
 - Paramount Advantage thru Healthcare.gov –

which is the only provider in this area for government healthcare

- Deadline to enroll is December 15th
- UCC Plan B is not economical
- Jackie and children have better coverage with healthcare.gov than UCC Plan C
- Budget Reviewed & Discussion held
 - Dan Gahler made a motion to accept the proposed budget for 2018, 2nd Ann Diekman. MC

Robin Hansen moved and Steve Turnow 2nd to adjourn meeting. Meeting adjourned at 8:50 pm by Ed Gahler
