

Ordinance No. 173

An Ordinance levying a Corporate Tax for general revenue purposes of the city of Gamett for the current year; for opening and widening streets, avenues and alleys, and for building bridges, culverts and sewers and foot walks across streets, avenues and alleys; <sup>and</sup> for the purpose of paying interest and coupons on the bonds of the city of Gamett

Be it ordained by the Mayor and councilmen of the city of Gamett, Kansas:

Sec. 1

That a tax of nine (9) mills for general revenue purposes of the city of Gamett, including accrued indebtedness and current expenses for the year A. D. 1896, be, and the same is hereby levied on each and every dollar of taxable property in the city of Gamett, Kansas, as returned upon the assessment rolls of Anderson County, state of Kansas, for the year A. D. 1896.

Sec. 2.

That a tax of one (1) mill for the purpose of opening and widening streets, avenues and alleys, and for building bridges, culverts, sewers and foot walks across streets, avenues and alleys in the city of Gamett, Kansas, be and is hereby levied on each and every dollar of taxable property in the city of Gamett, Kansas as returned upon the assessment rolls of Anderson County, state of Kansas for the year A. D. 1896.

Sec. 3. That a tax of Five (5) Mills for the purpose of paying the interest and Coupons on all bonds of the City of Garnett, Kansas, and is hereby levied on each and every dollar of taxable property in the City of Garnett Kansas, as returned upon the assessment rolls of Anderson County, State of Kansas, for the year A.D. 1896.

Sec. 4. That the City Clerk of the City of Garnett shall furnish the County Clerk of the County of Anderson, State of Kansas, with a duly certified copy of this ordinance immediately after the taking effect thereof.

Sec. 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication according to Law.
